

Notice of review of polling districts and polling places 2019

In accordance with Section 18c of the Representation of the People Act 1983, and adhering to the revised timings laid out in the Electoral Registration & Administrations Act 2013, East Hertfordshire District Council is conducting a review of polling districts and polling places commencing 1 March 2019.

The council welcomes comments from electors within the authority area or within a parliamentary constituency which has any part in the authority area, on any aspect of the Council's proposals.

We welcome comments from interested persons or groups, particularly those with expertise in disability access issues on the proposals, the returning officer's representations or any other matter related to this review.

Details of the current arrangements along with the (Acting) Returning Officer's views will be made available online at www.eastherts.gov.uk/elections. Proposals will also be displayed in the main reception area at East Herts Council, Wallfields, Pegs Lane, Hertford SG13 8EQ and at its Council Offices at Charringtons House, The Causeway, Bishops Stortford, CM23 2ER.

Comments can be made in writing to the Electoral Services Manager at the address below or by e-mailing electors@eastherts.gov.uk. Any persons or organisations submitting comments, should provide their contact details and information on alternative places that may be used as polling places, preferably completing the online **Submission Form** on Council's website www.eastherts.gov.uk.

All comments received will be made public as part of the final report.

The deadline for submitting comments is **Friday 17 May 2019**.

Details of the final arrangements for polling districts and polling places, taking into consideration comments received, will be published no later than 1 December 2019 on the website and at the above locations.
