Ware Neighbourhood Area Plan

Subject Matter: Ware Neighbourhood Area Plan contains policies relating to housing, the environment, design, heritage, local green space, employment, travel, and community facilities amongst others.

Area covered: The Neighbourhood Plan covers Ware Chadwell, Ware Christchurch, Ware St. Mary's and Ware Trinity Wards

Period of Publication: Representations should be made in writing between the 1st December 2022 and the 26th January 2023. Representations must be received by 5pm on the 26th January 2023.
