HELP with child care costs

Housing Benefit and Council Tax Support rules include help for people who have to pay child car e costs.

If you receive T ax Cr edits, the child car e costs you pay may also be taken into account.

The assistance is in the form of a "disr egar d" of up to £175.00 per week of ear nings per family when child car e char ges ar e paid for one child, or up to £300.00 per week, when char ges ar e paid for two or mor e children.

Who can qualify?

The disr egar d will apply wher e a claimant is:

- A lone par ent in paid work for mor e than 16 hours per week.
- A member of a couple, both of whom ar e in paid work, more than 16 hours per week.
- A member of a couple wher e one is in paid work for mor e than 16 hours per week and the other is "incapacitated".

"Incapacitated" means disabled or blind and getting certain benefits

What child care costs count?

The disr egar d applies to childr en only until the first Monday in September after their 15th birthday (16th birthday if disabled).

The car e must be pr ovided by either:-

- A register ed childminder .
- A register ed nursery .
- For childr en aged 8 and over , but under 15 (16 if disabled), car e provided by a local authority .
- A child car e scheme exempt fr om registration.

How much?

For Housing Benefit and Council ax Support, average weekly childcar e costs ar e calculated through the year and costs of up to £300.00 per week ar e "disr egar ded" from income. The maximum childcar e disr egar d for one child is £175.00 per week.

How to find out if you qualify?

If you receive Housing Benefit or Council ax Support, contact East Herts Benefit Service **NOW!**

You will be asked to pr ovide pr oof of the childminder's registration.

Example 1

Family with one child whose 15th birthday (16th if child is disabled) is on 30 June 2005, r elevant child car e char ges of $\pounds 170.00$ per week ar e incurr ed.

A disregar d of £170.00 per week applies until 5 September 2005, fr om 6 September the disr egar d will no longer apply.

Example 2

Family with two childr en, aged 14 and 9. Child car e costs of £210.00 per child, per week ar e paid - a total of £420.00 per week.

A disregar d of £300.00 per week applies. Note: The maximum disr egar d applies to the total r elevant child car e charges incurr ed, not for each child.

Example 3

Family with two children, aged 10 and 16. Child care charges of £200.00 per week are incurred (£120.00 for the younger child and £80.00 for the older child).

Disregar d of £175.00 applies. Relevant childcar e char ges are incurr ed for only one child as the second child is not of qualifying age.

What if I do not get Benefit now?

If you do not alr eady r eceive Housing Benefit or Council Tax Support and you ar e paying for child car e and you think you may qualify, why not apply?
