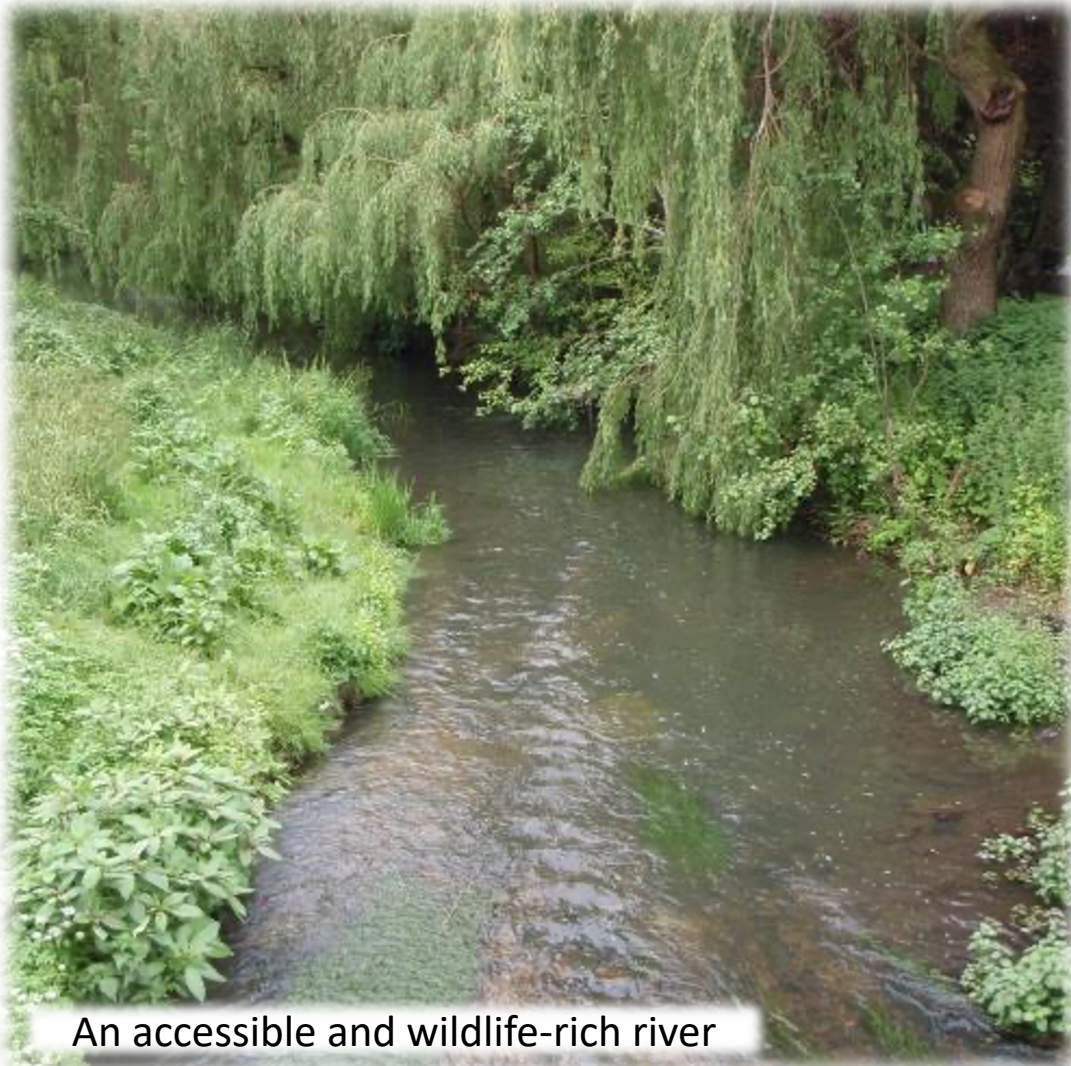


Castle Park

A Lottery funded project to enhance Bishop's Stortford's town centre park



New tennis courts have been built, located closer to other recreational facilities including the skate park and Grange Paddocks Leisure Centre

Banks of the River Stort have been regraded to create better habitat conditions. In-channel works will soon be carried out to encourage more vegetation growth within the river

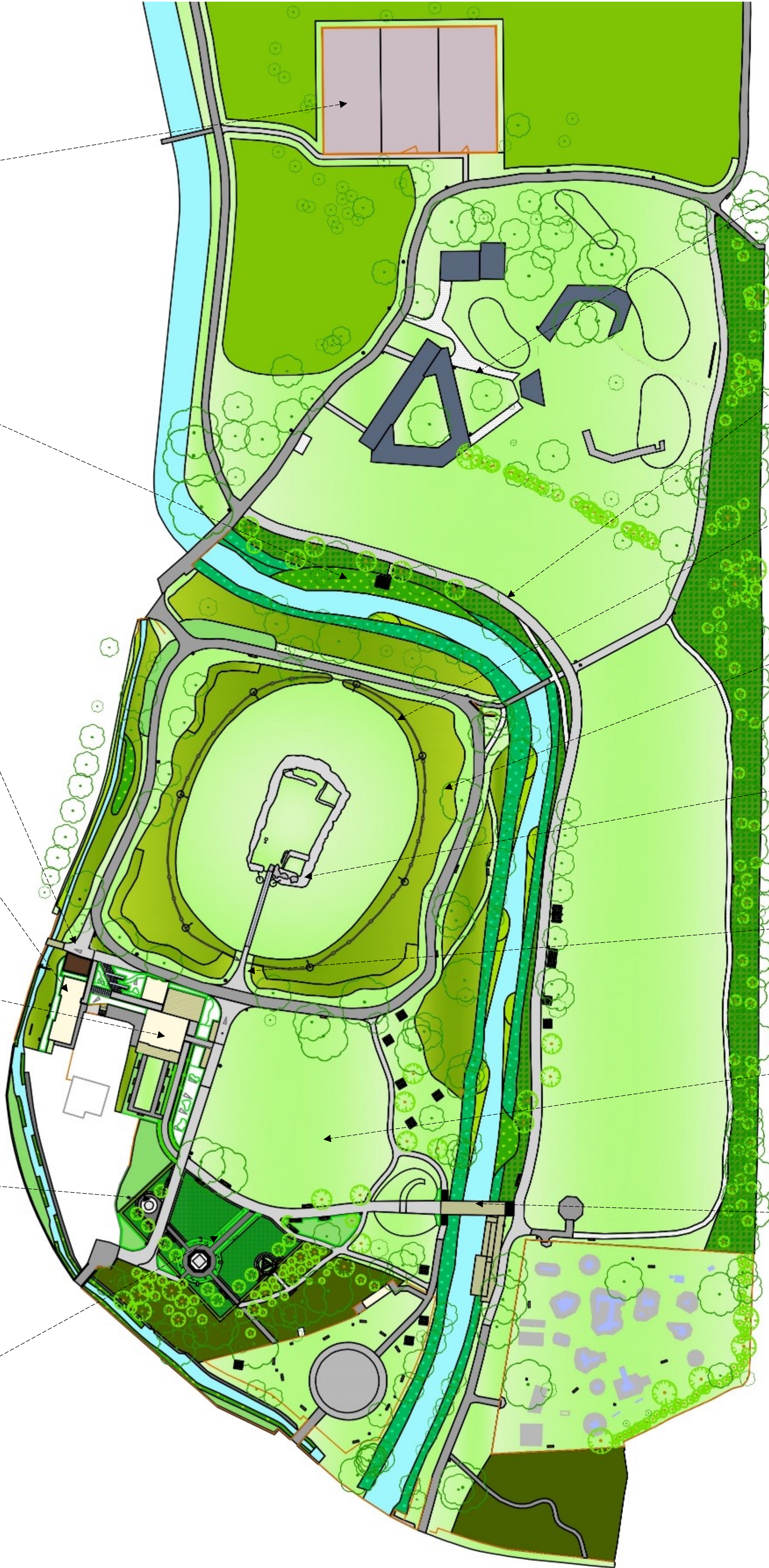
Interpretation boards will explore the long history of the site
