Taking photos and videos at your event



If you take photos or videos to share via social media or other means, you must get consent from everyone being captured on film.

You could use a form to get consent to be filmed from people who agree to be in your films and photos. Alternatively, you could print out posters and pin them up at your event to let people know that photos and films are being taken.

You can find examples of these later in this pack.

Here are our top tips for filming your event:

- Think about what you want to shoot
- Plan how you will frame the shots. How can you make it more interesting?
- Keep your phone or camera steady
- Hold your shot to ensure you capture what you're filming for long enough
- Remember sound. Is the environment quiet enough?
- Be aware of light conditions be careful when shooting directly into the light as that will create silhouettes and shadows



Gathering feedback



How you get feedback from the attendees at your event is up to you, but it's important that you let us know how your event went, so that we can evaluate the success of this year's Arts in East Herts celebration and make it even better for next year.
